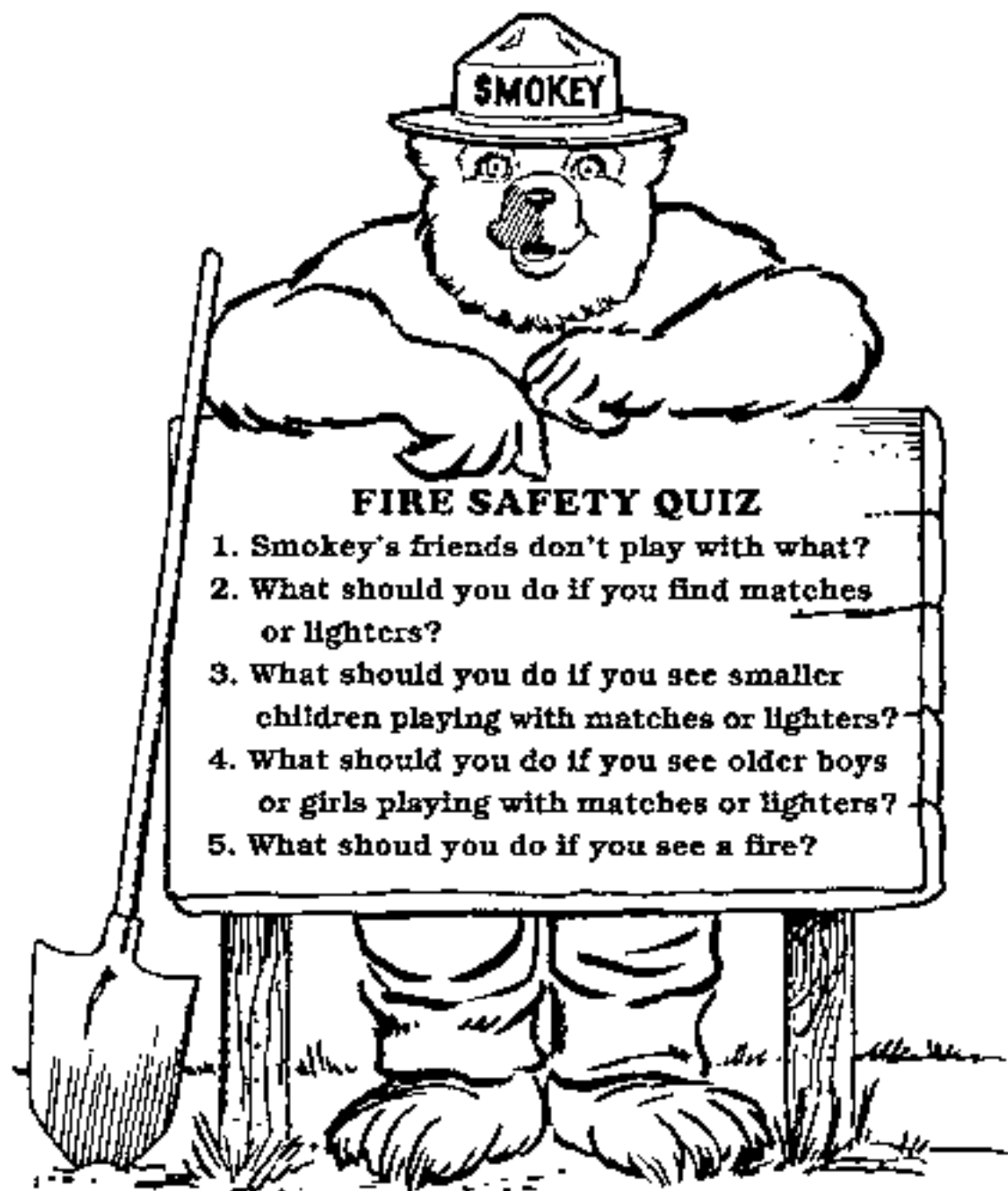

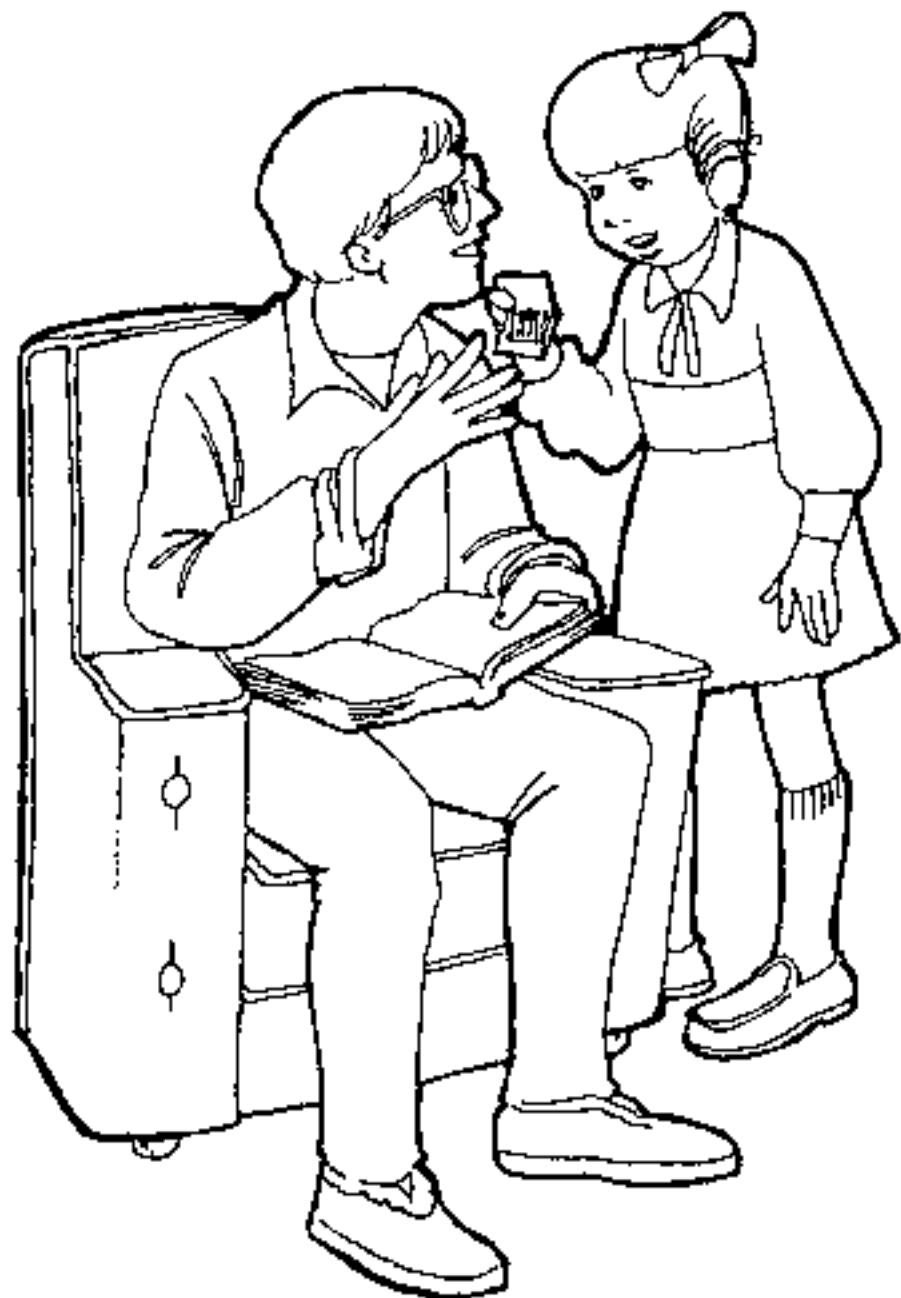
FIRE SAFETY QUIZ

5. What should you do if you see a fire?

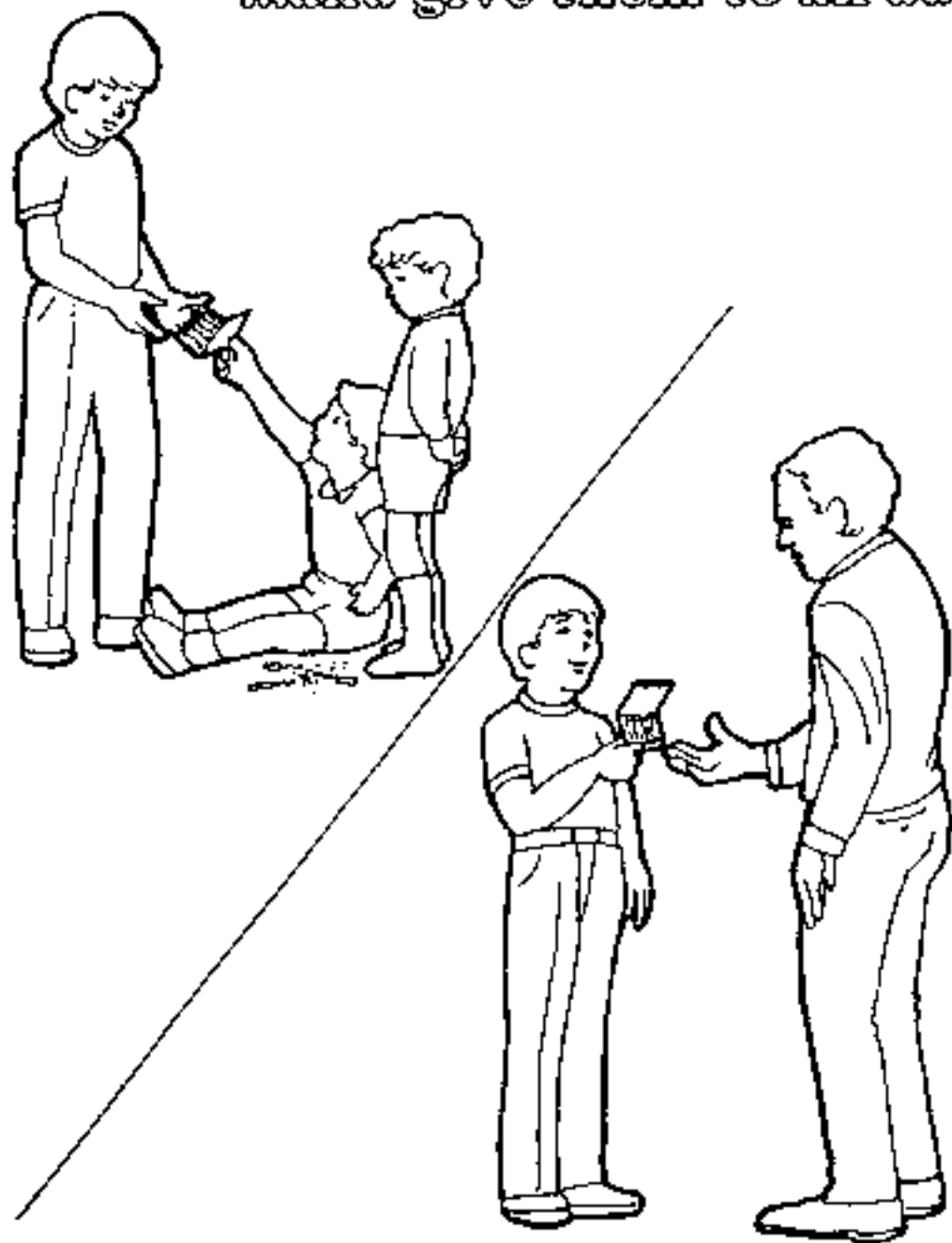
**Smokey's friends don't play

Tell a grownup if you see bigger boys or girls playing with matches or lighters!

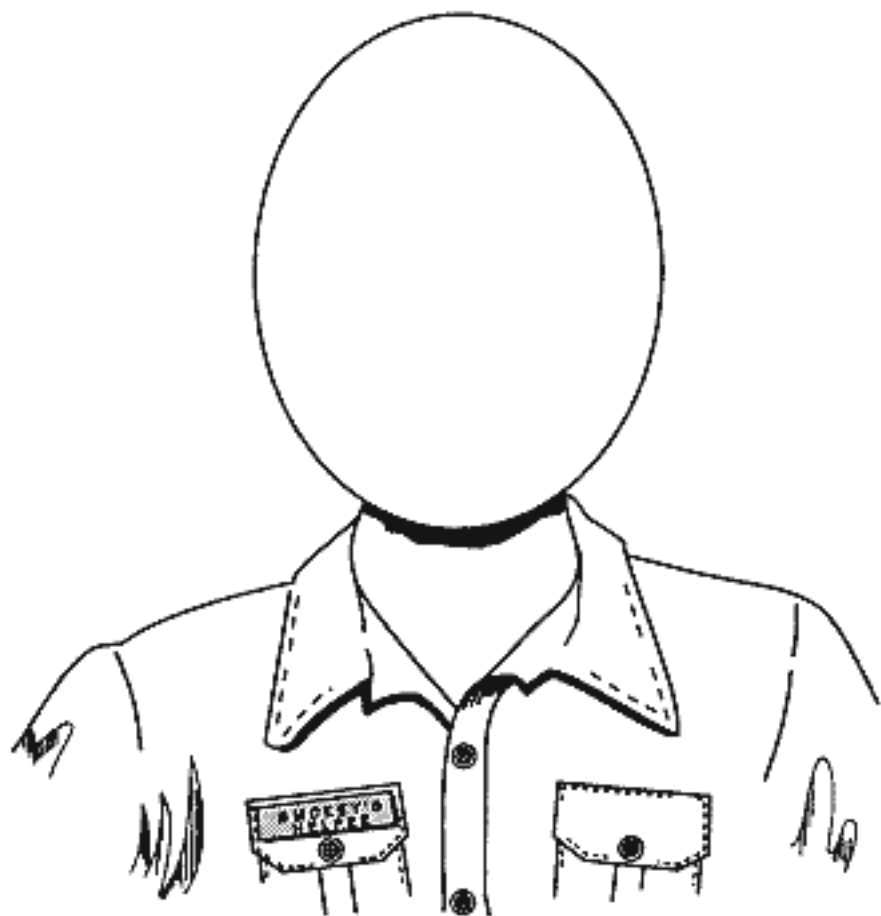


If you see a fire, tell a grownup to "Call the Fire Department"!
